



Dicing With Life CIC - Code of Conduct

1. Purpose

Dicing With Life believes our community should be truly open for everyone. As such, we are committed to providing a friendly, safe and welcoming environment for all, regardless of gender, sexual orientation, disability, ethnicity, religion, preferred tabletop gaming systems or methods of gaming.

This code of conduct outlines our expectations for participant behaviour as well as the way we will deal with unacceptable behaviour.

We invite all sponsors, volunteers, games masters, collaborators, attendees, and other participants to help us realise a safe and positive community experience for everyone.

2. Expected Behaviour

Be considerate, respectful, and collaborative.

Refrain from demeaning, discriminatory or harassing behavior and speech.

Be mindful of your surroundings and of your fellow participants.

Alert community organisers if you notice a dangerous situation or someone in distress.

Participate in an authentic and active way. In doing so, you help to create Dicing With Life and make it your own.

3. Unacceptable Behaviour

Unacceptable behaviors include: intimidating, harassing, abusive, discriminatory, derogatory or demeaning conduct; theft; assault; or drug use by any members of Dicing With Life and those attending related events. All Dicing With Life venues may be shared with members of the public; please be respectful to all patrons of these locations.

Harassment includes: offensive verbal comments related to gender, sexual orientation, race, religion, disability, or any other offensive verbal conduct; inappropriate use of nudity and/or sexual images in public spaces (including presentation slides); deliberate intimidation (verbal or physical), stalking or following; harassing photography or recording; sustained disruption of games or other events; inappropriate physical contact, and unwelcome sexual attention.

4. Consequences Of Unacceptable Behaviour

Unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated whether by other attendees, organisers, venue staff, sponsors, or other patrons of the Dicing With Life venues.

Anyone asked to stop unacceptable behaviour is expected to comply immediately.

If a participant engages in unacceptable behaviour, the community organisers may take any action they deem appropriate, up to and including expulsion from the community without warning or refund. Where a safeguarding issue is raised, the Safeguarding Policy will also come into effect.

5. What To Do If You Witness Or Are Subject To Unacceptable Behaviour

If you are subjected to unacceptable behaviour, notice that someone else is being subject to unacceptable behaviour, or have any other concerns, please notify a Dicing With Life organiser as soon as possible.

The Dicing With Life team will be available to help participants contact venue security or local law enforcement, to provide escorts, or to otherwise assist those experiencing unacceptable behaviour to feel safe in the community.

6. Scope

We expect all community members, sponsors, volunteers, games masters, collaborators, attendees, and other guests to abide by this code of conduct at all venues and related social events.
